

Multi Crew Coordination Course Factsheet

Purpose:

A Multi-Crew Coordination Course allows you to operate as a pilot in a multi-crew environment. Most airlines will require an MCC Course to be completed prior to applying for a First or Second Officer position.

Pre-requisites:

To complete Aerosphere's MCC Course, you must:

- Hold a PPL or CPL
- Hold an Instrument Rating (and Multi-Engine Endorsement)
- Have passed the CASA ATPL Human Factors exam

Cost:

• \$6750 + GST

Duration:

- 1 Day of online theory
- 15 hours of simulator training, usually spread over 3 contact days

Location:

 The simulator component is conducted at Flight Experience Melbourne, in Docklands, in their Boeing 737-800 simulator.

Common questions:

- Is the course CASA Approved? Yes.
- Who is Aerosphere? Aerosphere is a CASA Approved Part 142 training organisation, specialising in advanced simulator training. All of Aerosphere's instructors have airline experience.
- When should I complete an MCC? You can complete it at any time if you meet the
 course pre-requisites, but in the current aviation climate we recommend completing
 the course to be able to accept any job opportunities that arise.
